## PETITION OF DEFENDANT FOR REMOVAL TO UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT

Comes now your petitioner, Insurance Company of North America, a Corporation, defendant in the above-styled cause, and would show unto this Honorable Court as follows:

- America is a corporation organized and existing by virtue of the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, with its principal place of business in the State of Pennsylvania, in the City of Philadelphia; that the plaintiff, Fred H. Mitchell, is now and was at the time of the commencement of this suit a resident citizen of the State of Alabama; that this is an action brought by a citizen of the State of Alabama against a citizen of the State of Pennsylvania, and is wholly between citizens of different states, and one which can be fully determined between them.
