TO THE HONORABLE F. W. HARE, JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA, SITTING IN EQUITY:

Your Orators, Josephine Nimmo Arbogast, Helen Nimmo, Regene N. McNair and Sarah N. Dolive, present this Bill of Complaint against Amos Garrett, and thereupon your Orators complain and show unto the Court and your Honor as follows:

- 1. Your Orator, Josephine Nimmo Arbogast, is over twenty-one years of age and a resident of Chipley, Florida; Helen Nimmo is over twenty-one years of age and a resident of Milton, Florida; Regene N. McNair is over twenty-one years of age and a resident of Union Springs, Alabama and Sarah N. Dolive is over twenty-one years of age and a resident of Loxley, Alabama. The Respondent, Amos Garrett, is over twenty-one years of age and a resident of Robertsdale, Alabama.
- 2. Your Orators own and are in the actual quiet and peaceable possession of the following described real property situated in Baldwin County, Alabama, to-wit: Northwest Quarter of Southwest Quarter of Section Twenty-one (21), Township Five (5) South Range Three (3) East.
- some right, title or interest in or encumbrance upon the said lands; no suit is pending to enforce or test the validity of such title, interest in or encumbrance upon the said lands and your Orators bring this Bill of Complaint against the said Respondent to settle the title to the said lands and to clear up all doubts and disputes conserning the same. Your Orators here and now call upon the said Respondent to set forth and specify his right, title or interest in or encumbrance upon the said lands or any part thereof and how and by what instrument the same is derived and created.

PRAYER FOR PROCESS

Your Orators further pray that upon a final hearing of this cause your Honor will make and enter a Decree against the said Respondent, quieting title to the said land and adjudging and decreeing that your Orators are the owners thereof in their own right; that title thereto is in them, forever quieting your Orators' title against the said Amos Garrett, adjudging and decreeing that he is without right, title or interest in the said lands and that he has and holds no encumbrance upon the same.

Your Orators further pray for such other, further and general relief as they may be equitably entitled to the premises considered.
