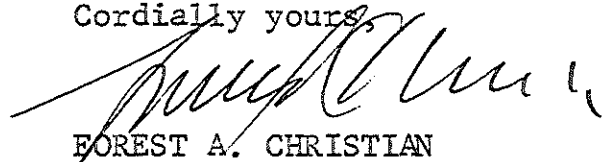

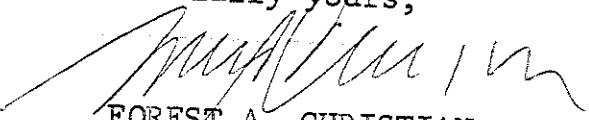
Dear Judge Mashburn:

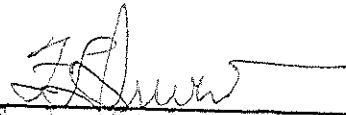

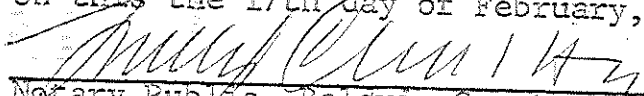
