
SUGGESTION OF BANKRUPTCY AND MOTION TO STAY PROCEEDINGS

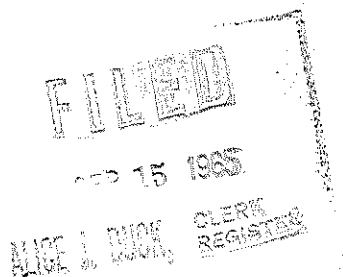
Comes now defendant and respectfully shows that he has on September 13, 1965, filed bankruptcy proceedings in the U.S. District Court, Southern District of Alabama.

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant, the sum of FIVE HUNDRED FORTY-THREE AND 31/100 (\$543.31) DOLLARS, due from him by promissory note made by him on, to-wit: the 31st day of July, 1961, and payable on, to-wit: the 31st day of March, 1964, with interest thereon.
