COMPLAINT

COUNT ONE

The plaintiff claims of the defendant, Cleo Cox, Eighteen Hundred Dollars (\$1800.00) damages for that heretofore on to-wit, June 14, 1965, the said defendant so negligently operated a motor vehicle on U. S. Highway 31 at the point where the said highway intersects with Alabama Highway No. 181 in Baldwin County, Alabama, so as to cause the plaintiff's motor vehicle which was being operated on U. S. Highway 31 at said time and place to run off of the paved portion of the said highway and into a utility pole and as a proximate result of the negligence of the said defendant the plaintiff's motor vehicle was damaged in this: the left front fender was demolished; the steering rod was broken; the cab was bent, broken and damaged; seven tires and tubes on plaintiff's motor vehicle and log trailer were destroyed and plaintiff was without the use of its said motor

vehicle for a long period of time, all to its damages aforesaid, hence this suit.

COUNT TWO

The plaintiff claims of the defendants Eighteen Hundred Dollars (\$1800.00) damages for that heretofore on to-wit, June 14, 1965, the defendant, Cleo Cox, who was then and there an agent, servant or employee of the defendant, A. E. Cox, acting within the line and scope of her authority as such agent, servant or employee, so negligently operated a motor vehicle on U. S. Highway 31 at the point of the said Highway's intersection with Alabama Highway No. 181 in Baldwin County, Alabama, so as to cause plaintiff's motor vehicle to leave the paved portion of U. S. Highway 31 at said time and place and further causing it to run into, upon or against the utility pole and plaintiff's motor vehicle was damaged in this: the left front fender was demolished; the steering rod was broken; the cab was bent, broken and damaged; seven tires and tubes on plaintiff's motor vehicle and log trailer were destroyed and plaintiff was without the use of its said motor vehicle for a long period of time, all to its damages aforesaid; plaintiff avers that all of its damages were caused as a proximate result of the negligence of the defendant, Cleo Cox, who was then and there an agent, servant or employee of the defendant, A. E. Cox, acting within the line and scope of her authority as such agent, servant or employee, hence this suit.






1. Said complaint does not state a cause of action.
