The Plaintiff claims of the Defendants TWO HUNDRED SIXTY-FOUR & 80/100 (\$264.80) DOLLARS, due by promissory note made by them on the 6th day of October, 1964, and payable in eight (8) monthly installments of THIRTY-THREE AND 10/100 (\$33.10) DOLLARS each, beginning November 28, 1964, and said note being payable at the First National Bank of Fairhope, Fairhope, Alabama; and the Plaintiff avers that the Defendants defaulted in the payment due November 28, 1964, and the Plaintiff under the terms of said note declared the entire unpaid balance due and payable.

And the Plaintiff avers that in said note and as a part of the consideration thereof, the Defendants have expressly waived their rights to claim personal property as exempt to them under the Constitution and laws of the State of Alabama and agreed to pay an attorney's fee for the collection thereof, and the Plaintiff




