This cause coming on to be heard is submitted upon the original Bill of Complaint, Answer and Cross Bill, and Answer to the Cross Bill.

The testimony of witnesses on behalf of the Complainant and the Respondent, Cross-Complainant, being taken orally in open Court.

The Court, after considering the pleadings and hearing the testimony of the witnesses is of the opinion that the Complainant, William H. Green, is not entitled to the relief prayed for, and that the Respondent, and Cross-Complainant, Dorothy C. Green, is entitled to the relief prayed for in her Cross Bill.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Respondent—Cross-Complainant, DOROTHY C. GREEN, and the Complainant—Cross-Respondent, WILLIAM H. GREEN, be, and the same are hereby disolved, and that the said DOROTHY C. GREEN is forever divorced from the said WILLIAM H. GREEN.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the said DOROTHY G.

GREEN shall not again marry, except to the said WILLIAM H. GREEN, until sixty

days after the rendition of this decree, and that if an appeal is taken within

sixty days, she shall not again marry, except to the said WILLIAM H. GREEN, during

the pendency of said appeal.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the said WILLIAM H.

GREEN be, and he is hereby required to pay to the said DOROTHY C. GREEN, as permanent alimony, the sum of TWENTY (\$20.00) DOLLARS per month, such payment to be made on or before the 10 day of May, 1942, and a like payment on the same date of each succeeding month thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the said WILLIAM H.

GREEN be, and he is hereby required to pay to BEEBE & HALL, as Solicitors for

DOROTHY C. GREEN, the sum of FIFTY (\$50.00) DOLLARS, as a reasonable attorney's fee
in this cause.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that WILLIAM H. GREEN pay the costs herein to be taxed for which execution may issue.

And now comes the Respondent and for answer to the Complainant's Bill of Complaint and to each count thereof, separately and severally, says:

- 1. She admits that she and the Complainant are both over twenty-one years of age, and that the Complainant is a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, and has been for more than one year next preceding the filing of this Bill of Complaint. She denies that she is a non-resident of the State of Alabama, but on the contrary, states that she is now and has been for more than three years a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, living at Bay Minette.
- 2. She admits the allegations contained in Paragraph 2 in that she and the Complainant were lawfully married on February 15, 1939.
  - 3. She denies the allegations contained in Paragraph 3.
- 4. She denies each and every allegation contained in said Bill of Complaint, not herein specifically admitted, and demands strict proof of the same.

The Respondent for further answer to the Complainant's Bill of Complaint and praying that this may be taken as her cross bill, says:

- A: That the Complainant and the Respondent are both bona fide residents of Baldwin County, Alabama, living at Bay Minette;
  - B: That she and the Complainant are husband and wife;
- C: That on, to-wit, July 14, 1941, and at various times while they were living together as husband and wife at Bay Minette, Alabama, the Complainant, William H. Green, cursed, threatened and abused her and on various occasions did actual violence to her person by striking her; that his conduct was such as to give her every reasonable apprehension to believe, and she did actually believe that if she continued to live with him he would do further violence to her person that would necessarily endanger her life and health;

That the Complainant, William H. Green, is an habitual user of strong drink and when under influence of strong drink has an uncontrollable temper.

D: That she is in feeble health and has no money or property to support herself, and no funds to prosecute or defend this cause; that the Complainant, William H. Green, draws compensation from the Government and also owns and operates a cafe in Bay Minette, and is fully capable of providing and caring for her.

Wherefore, the premises considered, the Respondent prays that your Honor will by proper process make the said William H. Green party respondent hereto and require him to plead, answer or demur to this, her cross bill, within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

The Respondent and Cross-Complainant prays that your Honor will order a reference to determine a reasonable alimony, pendente lite, and attorneys' fees to be paid to the Respondent and Gross-Complainant by the Complainant and Cross-Respondent.

The Respondent and Cross-Complainant further prays that upon a final hearing of this cause, your Honor will enter a decree awarding to her a decree of divorce, forever barring the bonds of matrimony existing between her and the said William H. Green, and that a further decree be granted to her swarding to her such reasonable amount as to your Honor may seem just and proper as permanent alimony.

The Respondent and Cross-Complainant prays for such other, further, different or general relief as she may be entitled to, and as in duty bound she will ever pray.

#### ANSWER OF CROSS-RESPONDENT.

Now comes William H. Green, complainant and cross-respondent herein, and for answer to the cross-bill filed herein against him by Dorothy C. Green, respondent and cross-complainant, says and alleges as follows:

A: He admits the allegations of Paragraph A of said cross-bill.

B: He admits the allegations of Paragraph B of said cross-bill.

C: He denies the allegations of Paragraph C of said cross-bill and alleges that he did not on the occasion or date mentioned in said paragraph curse, threaten or abuse the said Dorothy C. Green, nor did he do so on any other occasion, nor did he do any actual violence to her person by striking her, nor was his conduct such as to give her every reasonable apprehendion to believe that he would do violence to her person that would necessarily endanger her life or health. He denies that he is an habitual user of strong drink and further denies that he has an uncontrollable temper, and alleges that such charge or charges is or are untrue.

D: He denies the allegations of Paragraph D of said cross-bill and alleges that he is not able physically or financially to provide for the said Dorothy C. Green and alleges that he sould not be required to do so after the misconduct of the said Dorothy C. Green as set forth in his original bill of complaint filed herein.

WHEREFORE, having fully answered, the said William H. Green prays the Court to dismiss the said cross-bill filed by the said Dorothy C. Green.
