You are hereby commanded to summons EUGENE M. HARPER, to appear and plead, answer or demur, within thirty days from the service hereof, to the complaint filed in the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, at the place of holding same by FORD MOTOR CREDIT COMPANY, a corporation.
