Examination by Mr. Duck

- Q. What is your name, please?
- A. Amos Beasley.
- Q. Were you involved in an automobile a ccident in Baldwin County, Alabama, back in September of 1964?
- A. Yes sir.
- Q. Do you know who was driving the other car?
- A. John Kendrick.
- Q. Did you talk to him at the scene of the accident?
- A. Yes sir.
- Q. Did he make himself known to you as John Kendrick John Carlton Kendrick?
- A. The highway patrolman came up -
- Q. And it was made known to you that that was the name of the person?
- A. Yes sir.
- Q. Did you suffer personal injuries as a result of that accident?
