Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of FIVE THOUSAND AND NO/100 (\$5,000.00) DOLLARS as damages, for that, heretofore and on, to-wit: the 26th day of September, 1964, the Plaintiff was riding in an automobile on Highway Alabama No. 87, at a point thereon five (5) miles north of its intersection with U. S. Highway No. 90, which was then and there a public highway in Baldwin County, Alabama, and then and there the Defendant so negligently operated a motor vehicle as to run into, upon or against the automobile in which Plaintiff was riding, and thereby and as a proximate result and consequence thereof, the Plaintiff was injured in that she suffered a fracture of the transverse process of the second lumbar vertebra, she suffered multiple contusions and abrasions, she suffered multiple muscle injuries in and about her back, she was made otherwise sick, sore and lame; she was permanently injured; she was caused to expend considerable sums for medical treatment, hospital care, nursing and medicines in and about the treatment of her injuries, for all of which she claims damages as aforesaid.

SYBIL S. BEASLEY, BEING FIRST DULY SWORN, TESTIFIED:
Examination by Mr. Duck.

Q. Your are Mrs. Sybil S. Beasley?

A. Yes sir.

Q. Were you in the automobile with your husband when it was involved in an accident here in Baldwin County, Alabama, on the 26th day of September, 1964?

A. Yes sir, I was.

Q. Did you suffer injuries as a result of that accident Mrs. Beasley?

A. I did; I suffered a fracture of the transverse process of the second lumbar vertebra, also a bad blow to the left kidney, causing a deep bruise and blood clot to the kidney and some other minor bruises.

Q. Did you get a whip-lash injury to your neck?

A. It seems to have cleared up, but I did have a neck problem.

Q. Did you incur hospital and nursing bills and Doctor bills as a result of the accident?

A. I did.

Q. What was that?

A. I was hospitalized for eight days and had medical care for eight days and I was dismissed from the hospital and told that I could return to work when I felt able to move; that movement would ^{help} me, and I was off about a week after I got

hom and I then returned to my job.

Q. What was the total amount of your hospital and Doctor bills as a result of this accident?

A. Between \$350.00 and \$400.00, the best I remember; I have the records and the insurance company has records.

Q. And you lost better than two weeks from your job?

A. Yes sir.

Q. Where are you employed?

A. Blaum's as Secretary.

Q. What is your income per week?

A. \$80.00.

Q. Did you suffer much pain as a result of this accident?

A. Yes sir; there was a number of months before I could walk well and I still have some soreness and pain at the location of the fracture; most of the time I feel quite well.

Q. You can walk and work now?

A. Yes sir.
