Now comes the Plaintiff in the above styled cause and amends the complaint heretofore filed in said cause, so that as amended said complaint shall read as follows:

COUNT ONE:

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of FIFTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$15,000.00) as damages for that, on, to-wit, the 29th day of November, 1965, the Defendant, Clifford Williams, so negligently operated a motor vehicle on U. S. Highway No. 98, at a point in the City of Fairhope, Baldwin County, Alabama, said point being the intersection of Fels Avenue and Church Street, both public road of the City of Fairhope, as to cause or allow such vehicle to run into or against an automobile of the Plaintiff, which she was then and there operating at said time and place, and as a proximate result of the negligence of said Defendant, the Plaintiff was injured in this: she received severe injury to her back and spine; her neck was injured; her muscles were torn from her shoulder blade and from her neck; she was confined in a hospital; she was caused to incur medical and hospital expense; she was made sick and sore and she is permanently injured; she has lost wages as a result of this injury, all to the damage of the Plaintiff in the sum above mentioned; hence this suit.

COUNT TWO:

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of SEVEN
HUNDRED FIFTY AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$750.00) as damages for that, on
to-wit, the 29th day of November, 1965, the Defendant, Clifford
Williams, so negligently operated a motor vehicle on U. S. Highway
No. 98, at a point in the City of Fairhope, Baldwin County, Alabama

said point being the intersection of Fels Avenue and Church Street, both public roads of the City of Fairhope, as to cause or allow such vehicle to run into or against an automobile of the Plaintiff, which she was then and there operating at said time and place, and as a proximate result of the negligence of said Defendant, the automobile of the Plaintiff was damaged and demolished, all to the damage of the Plaintiff in the sum above mentioned; hence this suit.
