The undersigned being the only parties interested in the above entitled matter, hereby petition the Court for approval of the following agreement and settlement, and agree and represent to the Court as follows:

That they are subject to the provisions of the Workmen's Compensation Law of Alabama, as amend-

ed. That the said employee, aged \_\_\_\_\_, residing at 112 Bouler Avenue, Bay Minette  
can

Alabama, who can not read and understand the English language, did on the 8th day of

August, 19 62 on or about \_\_\_\_\_ o'clock \_\_\_\_\_ M., sustain injury by accident while

employed by said employer, which injury occurred at near Chunchula, Alabama resulting in

temporary total and permanent partial disability of said employee and consisted of

10 weeks temporary total disability and injuries to head, eyes, and

neck, resulting in 25% permanent partial disability.

That said employee was receiving, at the time of injury, wages at the rate of \$ 100.00 per week.

Therefore, it is hereby agreed that the employee is entitled to and shall receive compensation for said

injury from the employer beginning 8-9- 19 62, at the rate of \$ 33.00

per week during disability payable as follows: Already paid and 290 weeks at \$16.25 per

for 10 weeks week, commuted as prescribed by law and payable in a lump sum of

\$4232.65 upon approval of this petition.

\_\_\_\_\_ ; all subject to the limitations  
of said Act, and the employee agrees to give proper receipts for each payment made hereunder.

The employee acknowledges that he has received <sup>all</sup> ~~to date~~ medical and surgical treatment and benefits given by said Act and the employer agrees to continue to furnish the same, if any be necessary, to the extent and in the manner required by said Act. The employee agrees to present himself for examination, or if physically unable to do so, to submit to examination by the physician or physicians designated by the employer, when requested.

This settlement is substantially in accordance with Sections 278 and 279 of the 1940 Code of Ala., as amended. When all payments hereunder have been made the employer shall be, and hereby is released from all claims on account of said injury, under said Act or otherwise. This settlement contains the whole agreement between the parties hereto.
