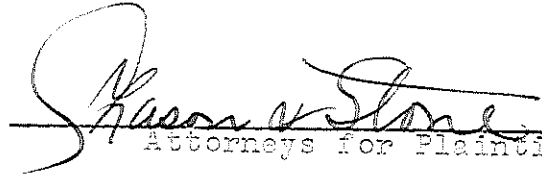

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of Six Hundred Sixty and 69/100 Dollars (\$660.69) due by promissory note made by him on, to-wit; March 29, 1954, and payable on, to-wit; June 1, 1954, with interest thereon from September 30, 1955, at the rate of six per cent. (6%) per annum, which sum of money is due and unpaid.

The Plaintiff avers that in, by and as a part of said note the Defendant agreed to pay all costs of collecting, or securing or attempting to collect or secure such debt, including a reasonable attorneys' fee whether the same be collected or secured by suit or otherwise and the Plaintiff further claims of the Defendant the farther and additional sum of One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) as such attorneys' fee.

The Plaintiff further avers that in, by and as a part of said note the Defendant waived as to this debt or any renewal thereof, all rights to exemption under the Constitution and Laws of Alabama as to personal property and of this waiver the Plaintiff now claims the benefit.
