IN EQUITY:

Your Complainant, DAISY HADLEY, respectfully represents and shows unto your Honor and this Honorable Court, as follows:

1. That the Complainant and the Respondent are both bona fide residents of Baldwin County, Alabama, and over the age of twenty-one years;
2. That the Complainant and the Respondent were married at Brewton, Alabama, on, to-wit, October 29, 1940;
3. That on, to-wit, December 23, 1940, and at various times prior thereto the Respondent threatened and abused the Complainant, and threatened to do violence to her person; that the conduct of the Respondent was such as to give the Complainant every reasonable apprehension to believe and she did actually believe that if she continued to live with him he would carry out his threats and do violence to her person which would necessarily endanger her life and health.

Wherefore, the premises considered, the Complainant prays that this Honorable Court will by proper process make the said HOIL HADLEY party respondent to this Bill of Complaint and by appropriate orders, require him to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

Complainant further prays that upon a final hearing of this cause, your Honor will give and grant unto her a decree of absolute divorce, forever barring the bonds of matrimony existing between her and the Respondent; that she be granted such other,

further, different or general relief as she may be in equity and good conscience entitled to receive, and as an duty bound she will ever pray.

My name is Daisy Hadley. I live at Perdido, in Baldwin County, Alabama. I am over twenty-one years of age. Hoil Hadley is over twenty-one years of age and a resident of Perdido, in Baldwin County, Alabama. Hoil Hadley and I were married at Brewton, Alabama, on October 29, 1940. We lived together as husband and wife, in Baldwin County, Alabama, until December 23, 1940. We have not lived together as husband and wife since that time. We have no children. The Respondent is a man who drinks some, and while under the influence of strong drink has an uncontrollable temper. The Respondent, while we were living together as husband and wife, often threatened and abused me, and many times threatened to do violence to my person. His conduct was such that I had every reasonable apprehension to believe and did believe that if I continued to live with him as his wife, he would carry out his threats and do violence to my person which would necessarily endanger my life and health. I know that conditions are such that it is impossible for me to live with him as his wife.

ELMER PIPKIN, A WITNESS FOR THE COMPLAINANT, DEPOSES AND SAYS:

My name is Elmer Pipkin. I live at Bay Minette, in Baldwin County, Alabama, I am personally acquainted with Daisy Hadley and Hoil Hadley. They live at Perdido, in Baldwin County, Alabama. I have known the Complainant and the Respondent all of their lives. The Respondent is a man who drinks quite often and when under the influence of strong drink, has a high and uncontrollable temper. I have been around him some, and it is generally known that the conduct of the Respondent was such that the Complainant could not live with him. I know that they have not lived together as husband and wife for quite a while, and since December 23, 1940.
