AFFIDAVIT

ANTHONY SUTE, first being duly sworn, deposes and says as follows:

My name is Anthony Sute and I am Cashier of the Farmers & Merchants Bank at Foley, Alabama, who is the plaintiff in the case in Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama vs. Mac Muzik which is a suit in detinue, for One (1) 1954 Model Plymouth 2 door Sedan, Motor No. 20540156; Serial No. P24-90923; with the value of the use thereof from, to wit: the 13th day of August, 1957. The sheriff can not locate this automobile which was mortgaged to the Farmers & Merchants Bank at Foley, Alabama by a chattle mortgage note dated December 7, 1956 which note is recorded in Deed Book 271, Page 259. There is a balance due on the note in the amount of \$374.82. Said note provides for a reasonable attorney's fee which plaintiff alleges to be \$75.00. Although value of said automobile and damages for detention thereof exceeds the principal amount due on the note of \$374.82 plus \$25.00 interest, plus \$75.00 attorney's fee for a total of \$474.82, the Farmers & Merchants Bank of Foley, Alabama claims only this amount as damages in lieu of full value of the automobile.
