This cause being submitted on the Bill and Answer both as amended, the Complainant is entitled to relief.

It is adjudged and decreed by the Court, upon consideration, that the mortgage made by complainant John C. Dean and his wife to the defendant W.B. Paterson under the name of the W.B. Paterson Mercantile Company, dated May 14th, 1910, acknowledged May 14th, 1910, and recorded in the records of conveyances of Baldwin County, Alabama, conveying the following described real estate situated in the County of Baldwin and State of Alabama, to wit : that certain parcel of land beginning at the south-west corner of the north-east quarter of section 27, township 5 south, range 2 east, thence running east sixteen hundred (1600) feet, thence north six hundred and seventy-five feet (675 ft.), thence west sixteen hundred feet (1600), thence south six hundred and seventy-five (675) feet, to the place of beginning, containing twenty-four and 82/100 acres more or less, and also the following real estate, beginning at a stake on the section line between sections twenty-seven and twenty-six and running north and south, said stake being at the half section line, running thence north nine chains and ninety-six links, thence west sixteen chains, thence south nine chains and ninety-six links, thence east sixteen chains to the place of beginning, said place of beginning being on the south-east corner of the lot of land first above described, all said lands being in township 5 south of range 2 east in Baldwin County, and containing sixteen acres more or less, and the note for \$400 which said mortgage secured, were both satisfied in full before said mortgage was advertised for foreclosure ; that at the foreclosure sale thereof had at Bay Minette in said county on Monday, July 14th, 1913, at which

defendant W.L.Thompson purchased, no title or right to the land passed but the foreclosure of said mortgage was invalid and is hereby set aside and annulled; that said mortgage and note are annulled, and that they be surrendered and delivered by defendant W.B.Paterson and defendant W.L.Thompson into the hands of the Register of this Court forthwith, and that the Register mark them cancelled under this decree and turn them over to complainant Dean or his solicitors; that the defendants deliver and surrender up to the Register of the Court any foreclosure deed made under said foreclosure, and that the Register make it cancelled under this decree and deliver it to complainant or his solicitors; that the Register likewise cancel upon the records of conveyances of Baldwin County the said note and mortgage, and also said deed if recorded. It is further ordered that the defendants pay the costs of this cause, for which let execution issue.
