

Anderson, charges that the offense of Assault and Battery on Julia Kahalley was committed in the Town of Bay Minette by the defendant, Coy Mixon, within sixty days before the commencement of this prosecution, and in violation of Section 176 of the Code of By-Laws and Ordinances of the Town of Bay Minette, Alabama, adopted April 23, 1909 to go into effect on June 1st 1909, in words and figures as follows:

" Sec. 176. Any person who commits an assault or an assault and battery upon another person must on conviction, be fined not less than one nor more than one hundred dollars".


Mayors Court, October 20, 1915


