we, jointly and severally, bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and
administrators. Sealed with our seals, and dated the 29 day of April 1916

The conditions of the above obligations is such, that, whereas, on the
24th day of April 1916 John B. Wilters a Justice of the Peace, in and for
said County, rendered Judgment in favor of the said Foly Fertilizer Co.
W.A. Stoddard Agent against the said Joe Reading for the sum of \$22.70
debt, and \$5.10 costs, from which the said Joe Reading has applied for
and obtained an appeal to the next term of the Circuit Court of
Baldwin County. Now, therefor, if the said Joe Reading shall prosecute
