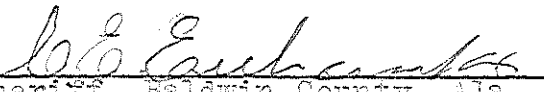
To the Honorable J. H. H. Smith, Judge of the Probate Court:
