The plaintiff sues to recover possession of the following tract of land in Baldwin County, Alabama, viz: Beginning at a point where the west bank of Bayou Durette or Stiggins Lake Bayou intersects the north bank of Tensaw River, thence running northeasterly up the west bank of Bayou Durette or Stiggins Lake Bayou to a point on the north line of Section forty three (43) or Louis Durette Grant (which point is sixty nine $84/100$ chains east of the south east corner of the claim of James Caller) thence south seventy eight (78) degrees thirty seven (37) minutes east twenty nine $26/100$ (29.26) chains to a stake, which is the north east corner of Section forty three (43) known as the Louis Durette Grant, thence north fifty (50) degrees twenty five (25) minutes east sixteen $72/100$ (16.72) chains to a point to the north corner of Section fifty (50) otherwise known as called the Louis Durette Grant, thence south eighteen (18) degrees and eighteen (18) minutes east seventy six (76) chains to a stake to the east corner of said section fifty (50), or Louis Durette Grant, thence south fifty (50) degrees and twenty five (25) minutes west ninety six $98/100$ (96.98) chains to a stake on the east bank of Tensaw River, thence up said east bank of Tensaw River with its meanderings to the place of beginning; being all of section fifty (50) and so much of Section forty three (43), all in Township one (1) North, Range one (1) east, as lies east of Bayou Durette or Stiggins Lake Bayou, of which she was in possession, and upon which, pending such possession, and before the commencement of this suit, the defendant entered and unlawfully withholds, together with Two thousand (\$2,000) dollars for the detention thereof.

Plaintiff demands a trial by jury.
