To Charles C. Styron

Take notice that I have this the day of March 1919, levied said execution on the following lands as your property, to-wit:

Fifteen & 3/4 acres of land bounded on the North by Victor Bertrand, on East by lands of Joe Brown, on South by lands of John Snellman and on West by the lands of Mrs. Mary Witt, Kennedy Grant in Tp. 8 S.R. 3 E., and being the same lands conveyed to R.M. Bishop by Thomas H. Benton and Eliza- beth Benton, his wife, by deed dated Nov. 16th, 1884 and recorded in Book T of Deeds, Pages 575-6, and which were also sold to R.M. Bishop by Losson Edner Walker and Samuel T. Walker by deed dated Sept. 3, 1894 and recorded in Deed Book T, Pages 579-580. Except one acre thereof formerly sold to John Snellman and one-fourth acre thereof formerly sold to C.J. Styron, both by R.M. Bishop, meaning to convey hereby 15-3/4 acres.

Also beginning at a stake 20 chs East of the Northwest corner of Section 26, in Tp. 8 S.R. 3 E., from thence run South 20 chs to a stake, thence East 20 chs to a stake, thence North 20 chs to a stake and thence West 20 chs to the place of beginning, containing 40 acres, the said land being also described as NW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of said Section 26, but it is a part of Nicholas Cook Grant, Section 38.

Bishop by Thomas H. Benton and Elizabeth Benton his wife, by deed dated November 16th, 1884, and recorded in Book T of Deeds, Pages 575-576, and which were also sold to R. N. Bishop by Lossen E. Baker and Samuel T. Walker, by deed dated September 3rd, 1894, and recorded in deed book 579-580.

Except one acre thereof formerly sold to John Snellman, and one fourth acre thereof formerly sold to C. J. Styron, both by R. N. Bishop, meaning to convey hereby fifteen and three fourths acres.
