IN ALABAMA:

Your Orator, the Peoples Fertilizer Company, a Corporation organized under the general laws of Alabama with its principal place of business at Foley, Alabama, humbly complaining of the Defendants, D. W. Fields and Hazel H. Fields, in a matter as will hereinafter appear, shows unto your Honor as follows:-

FIRST:

That the Defendants D. W. Fields and Hazel H. Fields are both over the age of twenty-one years; that both of said Defendants are now residing at Brownfield in the State of Texas.

SECOND:

Your Orator further shows unto your Honor that D. W. Fields is justly indebted to your Orator in the sum of Eight Hundred Twenty-two & 71/100 Dollars (\$822.71), together with interest thereon, which debt is evidenced by a Promissory Waive note executed by the said D. W. Fields on June 29, 1940, payable to the order of your Orator October 1, 1940, in and by the terms of which note the said D. W. Fields waived his right to exemption under the Constitution and laws of Alabama, and he also agreed to pay all costs of collecting said account, including a reasonable attorneys' fee; Your Orator further shows unto your Honor that Hazel H. Fields is the wife of the said D. W. Fields.

THIRD:

Your Orator further shows unto your Honor that on to-wit June 4, 1942, the said D. W. Fields was the owner of the following described real estate situated in Baldwin County, Alabama, to-wit:-

Southeast Quarter of Northeast Quarter; Northeast Quarter of Southeast Quarter, East half of Southeast Quarter of Southeast Quarter of Section Thirty-four (34), Township Four (4) South, Range Three (3) East, and the Southeast Quarter of Northeast Quarter of Section Three (3), Township Five (5) South, Range Three (3) East,

and that he was also the owner of the following described personal property to-wit:-

1 black cow, 3 Holstein cows, 3 red cows, 1 Jersey Bull, 1 frosty cow, 1 white cow, 35 Jersey cows, 1 gray mule; 1 John Deere tractor model "B", One 5 foot disc, 1 John Deere two-row potato planter, 1 John Deere two-row corn planter, 1 onehorse Cole planter, 1 John Deere grain drill, 1 Letz feed grinder and silage cutter, 1 Section harrow, 1 Oliver sprayer, 1 International 1 row potato digger, 1 John Deere 14-2 bottom breaking plow, 1 18 inch breaking plow.

Your Orator further shows unto your Honor that on June 4, 1942, for the purpose of hendering, delaying or defrauding your Orator the said D. W. Fields executed a voluntary conveyance to the said Hazel H. Fields, his wife, conveying to her the aforesaid lands and that on the same day the said D. W. Fields executed a Bill of Sale to the said Hazel H. Fields conveying to her the personal property heretofore mentioned; that a copy of the Deed conveying said real estate as aforementioned, which Deed is recorded in the office of the Judge of Probate of Baldwin County, Alabama, in 77 N. S. page 354, is hereto attached marked Exhibit "A" to this Bill of Complaint and made a part hereof, and a copy of said Bill of Sale, which said Bill of Sale was filed in the office of the Judge of Probate of Baldwin County, Alabama, on June 6, 1942, but has not yet been recorded, is attached hereto and marked Exhibit "B" to this Bill of Complaint and made a part hereof.

FOURTH:

Your Orator further shows unto your Honor that said Deed and Bill of Sale were made by the said D. W. Fields to the said Hazel H. Fields as aforesaid and that there was no consideration therefor flowing from the said Hazel H. Fields to her husband D. W. Fields.

PRAYER FOR PROCESS.

To the end that Equity may be had in the premises your Orator prays that your Honor will cause the usual writ of process to issue to the said Hazel H. Fields and D. W. Fields making them party defendants to this Bill of Complaint, requiring them to Plead,

answer, or demur to the same within the time as fixed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court; and that a copy of such process, together with a copy of this Bill of Complaint, be served on the said D. W. Fields and Hazel H. Fields by registered mail, postage prepaid marked "For delivery only to the person to whom addressed", with a demand for a return receipt to be addressed to the Register of this Honorable Court.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF.

The premises considered your Orator prays that upon a final hearing of this cause that your Honor will decree that said Deed and Bill of Sale were based upon insufficient consideration and that the same were made to hinder, delay and defraud your Orator in the collection of said indebtedness, and that your Honor will direct the Register of this Court to mark upon the record where said Deed and Bill of Sale are recorded in the Probate office of Baldwin County, Alabama, that the same are cancelled and held fornaught under a Decree of this Court. Your Orator further prays that on a final hearing of this cause that your Honor will decree that it have and recover of the Defendant D. W. Fields the sum of Eight Hundred Twenty-two & 71/100 Dollars (\$822.71) together with interest thereon, at the rate of 6% per annum since June 11, 1942, and together with a reasonable Solicitors' fee, and that unless the same be paid within a reasonable time to be fixed by your Honor, that the Register of this Court be directed to sell the aforesaid property, or so much thereof as may be necessary to satisfy your Orator's demand, together with the costs of this proceeding, said sale of said property to be held at public outcry in front of the Courthouse door of Baldwin County, Alabama, during the legal hours of sale to the highest bidder for cash, and that your Honor determine what notice of said sale shall be given. Your Orator further prays for such other, further and different relief as in Equity may seem just and meet, and your Orator will ever pray..

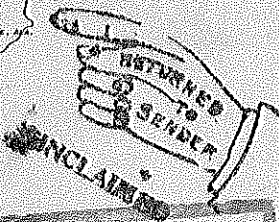

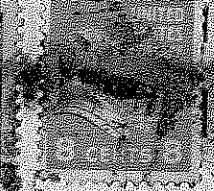

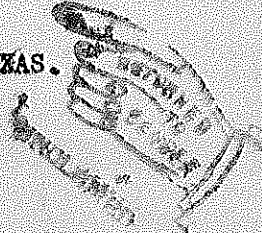
