

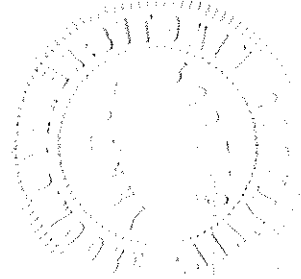

for said State and County, Personally appeared Tom Crabtree, who, being duly sworn, doth depose and say, that he is a resident citizen of the County of Baldwin, State of Alabama, and that he hereby makes known and declares under oath, that he has selected and claimed as exempted to him under the Constitution and laws of the State of Alabama, the following described personal property, to-wit:-

Eight head of cattle of the value of \$160.00; 4 horses of the value of \$400.00; one wagon of the value of \$15.00, and 3 hogs of the value of \$15.00. Also \$25.00 per month of my wages now due me or to be due me by Newport Turpentine & Rosin Co of Bay Minette, Ala., and also all of said wages in excess of \$25.00 per month, which with my personal property above mentioned will not exceed \$1000.00.

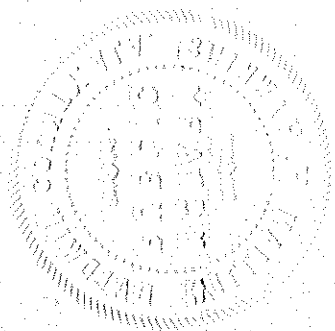
