The Plaintiff claims of the defendant one hundred and twenty dollars (\$120.00) due by promissory notes as follows; One note made by him on the 30th day of November, 1918 and payable ninety days after date, with interest thereon and one note made by him on the 30th day of November, 1918 and payable one hundred and eighty days after date, with interest thereon; the first note being for \$50.00 and the other note being for \$70.00, together with interest thereon.

The plaintiff claims of the defendant the further sum of \$20.00 as a reasonable attorneys fee for the bringing of this suit, the defendant having agreed in and by said note to pay the same.

The plaintiff alleges that in and by said promissory notes, and each of them that the defendant waived all his rights to exemptions under the Constitution and laws of the State of Alabama, and the plaintiff now claims the benefit of such waiver.
