These are the Changes in Section 6572 of the Code made by the 1923 Legislature:

In all cases in which the conviction was had on October 6, 1923, and thereafter: 15c instead of 10c per hundred words for record for Supreme Court, final record, and transcript and certificate.

\$4.00 instead of \$2.00 to Sheriffs for executing writ of arrest.

Not more than \$3.00 for stenographer's fees, when stenographer is used.

No item of cost will be allowed, not provided for in Section 6572 of the Code of 1907 as amended, special or local laws to the contrary notwithstanding.

Costs in appealed cases cannot be paid until appeal is finally disposed of, and certificate, made out and signed by Circuit Clerk, to be attached to transcript of the minutes now on file in this office, showing outcome of appeal, is received.

Costs in the second case cannot be paid until the convict has served the sentence in the first case. Clerks should retain cost bills until they are due.

Magistrates' and Constables' fees as well as Clerks, Sheriffs, and State Witnesses must be itemized.

No fees allowed witnesses before committing Magistrate.

We do not pay for service of a subpoena upon the sheriff.

The names of all witnesses for whom the Clerk issued a subpoena and on whom the Sheriff served a subpoena must be shown regardless of whether such witnesses proved attendance or not.
