- 3. - 4. Respondent denies each and all of the allegations of the Bill of Complaint which have not been specifically answered herein.

PRAYER FOR PROCESS

Respondent prays that this Answer be taken and treated in all respects as a Cross Bill and that a summons be issued to the Complainant and Cross Respondent requiring him to appear and plead, answer or demur to this Cross Bill within the time required by law.
