And now comes your Complainant, FLORENCE HINOTE and humbly complaining against the Respondent, JORDAN HINOTE, respectfully represents and shows unto your Honor and this Honorable Court as follows:

1.

That the Complainant and the Respondent are both residents of Baldwin County, Alabama, and over twenty-one years of age;

2.

That the Complainant and the Respondent were married at Robertsdale, in Baldwin County, Alabama, October 7, 1920, and lived together as husband and wife until in May, 1942;

3.

That in May, 1942, and at various times prior thereto, the Respondent committed actual violence on the person of the Complainant, by actually striking her; that the conduct of the Respondent was such as to cause the Complainant to have every reasonable apprehension to believe, and she did actually believe that the Respondent would continue to carry out his threats and abuses and continue to do violence to her person which would necessarily endanger her life and health.

PRAYER FOR PROCESS

Wherefore, the premises considered, your Complainant prays that your Honor will by proper process, make the said JORDAN HINOTE party respondent to this Bill of Complaint, requiring him to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

Complainant further prays that upon a final hearing hereof, your Honor will give and grant unto her an absolute decree of divorce, forever barring the bonds of matrimony existing between her and the Respondent; and that your Honor will give and grant unto her such other, further, different and general relief as she may be in equity and good conscience entitled to receive, and as in duty bound she will ever pray.
