The Grand Jury of said County further charge that before the finding of this Indictment and subsequent to the 30th day of November, 1919, Charley Weid did manufacture, sell give away or have in possession a still, apparatus, appliance or a device or substitute therefor, to-wit: A copper still, drum, pot, tub, can, barrel, pipe, trough, worm, condenser, capper, fermenter or flake stand to be used for the purpose of manufacturing prohibited liquors or beverages contrary to law; against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
