



TO THE HONORABLE F. W. HARE, JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

Your petitioner, Alice M. Hackley, was appointed guardian of Maude E. Murphy, a person of unsound mind, in the Probate Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, and letters of guardianship were issued to her on the 20th day of November, 1940.

Your petitioner represents unto Your Honor that she is a resident of the State of Alabama, County of Baldwin and over the age of twenty-one; that she is the guardian of her sister Maude E. Murphy, who is also over the age of twenty-one and is physically incapacitated of governing herself and managing her affairs due to affliction of infantile paralysis, which has affected both her mind and body. Your petitioner and her ward Maude E. Murphy are owners of a small house and lot located in Madison, Ohio, worth approximately \$1500 and receive a rental income of \$15.00 per month. The estate of the ward also includes property consisting of a mortgage held by the Geneva Trust & Savings Bank of Geneva, Ohio, for the face value of \$800.00, paying a monthly income of \$15.00 per month, so that the total income of the ward is \$22.50 per month. The only other property of the ward consists of clothing and furnishings in a single room located in the residence of your petitioner.


Your petitioner shows unto Your Honor that a sum equal to \$25.00 per month is necessary and essential for the proper care or maintenance of the ward Maude E. Murphy; that in order to make available to the guardian this sum it is necessary to use a small portion of the ward's principal since the income itself is inadequate; that it is also likely that special medical attention maybe necessary in the future; that some portion of the ward's principal may need to be used for her proper care.

Your petitioner shows unto Your Honor that the Probate Court, being a Court of limited and special jurisdiction, is only permitted, under the statutes and laws of Alabama, to

allow the income of the incompetent's estate to be expended by the guardian and that said Probate Court lacks authority to authorize any expenditures from the principal estate of the ward.

The premises considered, your petitioner prays that the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, In Equity, take jurisdiction of this cause and that it be transferred from the Probate Court of Baldwin County, to the Chancery side of the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama.

Your petitioner further prays that an order be entered allowing your petitioner to expend from the estate of Maude E. Murphy a sum not to exceed \$25.00 for each and every calendar month.



This day came Alice M. Hackley, by her attorneys, Demeree & Smith, and files her petition in due form in writing and under oath, asking that she may be appointed to be the guardian of the person and estate of said Maud E. Murphy, in this State, And it appearing to the court from adequate proof, that said incompetent has been declared to be physically incapacitated and incapable of governing herself, or of managing her affairs, by a competent tribunal in the State of Ohio; that said non compos mentis came to Fairhope, Baldwin County, Alabama, sometime in the month of June, 1940, with the consent of her former guardian, who was appointed by the Probate Court of Lake County, Ohio; that her said guardian has made an accounting and settlement of the property of his ward in the Probate Court of Lake County, Ohio; that the property of his said ward, consists of a house and lot near Madison, Ohio, of the approximate value of \$1500.00, renting at \$15.00 per month, and a mortgage held at the Geneva Trust & Savings Bank, of Geneva, Ohio, of the face value of \$800.00, and paying a monthly income of \$15.00; that no guardian has been appointed for the said incompetent in this State, and that said applicant is an inhabitant of this State, and is otherwise a suitable person for such guardianship.

Now therefor I, the said Register, respectfully report my findings as follows:



The Guardian has now on hand the sum of THREE HUNDRED FIFTY SEVEN DOLLARS and EIGHTY NINE CENTS.
