hundred dollars and costs

And, whereas, the said Gordon McCartha
has this day prayed an appeal from said judgment to the Circuit Court of said County:

Now, if the said Gordon McCartha shall appear at

and perform whatever sentence may be adjudged in said Court against him, then the above obliga-
