a judgment was rendered against them of which the following is a copy

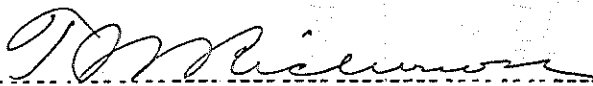
