

The Grand Jury of said County charge that before the finding of this Indictment and since November 10th, 1927, McArthur Lett, who name is to the grand jury otherwise unknown, Charlie Johns and Marshall Crandall, did, within the county of Baldwin, unlawfully transport in a quantity of five gallons or more liquors or beverages, the sale, possession, or transportation of which is now prohibited, by law,

against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
