TESTIMONY OF ELLA REESE.

My name is Ella Reese. I am over the age of 21 years and a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, residing at Little River. I am well acquainted with both Ella Reese Tate and Felix Tate, having known them all their lives, and having been in their home upon many occasions during their married life. In fact, I am personally and intimately acquainted with them both. I was present on the 25th of September, 1932, when Felix Tate struck Ella Reese Tate, and afterwards choked her, and his conduct at that time was such as to lead me to believe had she continued to live with him that her life would have been in danger. I think she was justified in quitting him under these conditions, as he is a man of violent temper, easily aroused, likely to commit an injury when in such condition.

I believe that Ella Reese Tate is the fit and proper person to have the control and custody of their child, Lonzie Tate, and I believe that Felix Tate is utterly unfit to have the rearing or the control of this child.

TESTIMONY OF ELLA REESE TATE.

My name is Ella Reese Tate. I am the Complainant in that certain suit now pending in the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, wherein Ella Reese Tate is Complainant and Felix Tate is Respondent. I was married to Felix Tate on the 3rd day of October, 1931, and lived with him until I was compelled to leave him in September, 1932. In September, 1932, his conduct became so violent toward me that I was forced to leave him. On or about September 25th, 1932, he struck me and choked me, and his conduct was such that I believe my life would have been in danger had I remained with him. He is a man of strong, ungovernable temper, and on occasions when he is seized with these fits of temper he is likely to strike or hit me, and it was impossible to live with him under these conditions.

I believe that I am better fitted to care for our child than is my husband, and that I would be the proper person to whom the custody should be awarded, as the child is only ten months of age and needs the constant care and attention of a mother, and my husband is not a fit person to have the custody of this child.
