Joe Kaiser was, on the 9 day of Dec 1937  
convicted in the Justice Court, Baldwin County, of the offense Burning turpentine  
and other forest negligently -

and by the judgment of said Court sentenced to pay a fine of Ten Dollars  
and court cost

And, whereas, the said Joe Kaiser  
has this day prayed an appeal from said judgment to the Circuit Court of said County:

Now, if the said Joe Kaiser shall appear at  
the next term of the Circuit Court, and from term to term thereafter until discharged, and abide by and  
perform whatever sentence may be adjudged in said Court against him, then the above obligation to be  
void; otherwise to remain in full force and effect.
