TO THE HONORABLE F. W. HARE, JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BAIDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA, AT LAW:

Now comes Jimmy Williams, who is of the age of eighteen years and a resident of said State and County, and respectfully alleges and represents unto your Honor and the Court as follows:

Heretofore on the 28th day of June; 1942, petitioner was, and had been for more than six months prior thereto, an employee of Bacon-McMillan Veneer Company, a Corporation, of Stockton in said State and County, and on said date while working as such employee petitioner was injured in that he lost the first phalanx of each of the following fingers, namely: his first finger or thumb, his second finger and his third finger. Petitioner's job was operating a veneer clipper and in some way his fingers were under the clipper and it caused said injury.

The said Bacon-McMillan Veneer Company carries its own insurance and has been paying to petitioner weekly compensation in the amount of \$7.15 each week. Petitioner is entitled to receive such compensation for a total of 622 weeks.

Petitioner, on account of said injury, has been unable to work and earn any money, and has gone into debt, and further avers that he will be able to return to work within the next ten days. Petitioner also needs money to contribute to his father for his support as he is old and unable to work.

Petitioner has offered to accept a less sum than the total of the above payments and alleges that it is for the best interest of himself to accept a lesser sum. Petitioner avers that he is willing to and will accept the sum of \$275.00 in settlement of his claim against his said employer.

Wherefore, the premises considered petitioner prays that your Honor will approve such settlement and will make all such judgments and orders as may be necessary or proper in the premises.
