and by the judgment of said Court sentenced to Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) fine

And, whereas, the said Eslie Newton has this day prayed an appeal from said judgment to the Circuit Court of said County: and demands trial by jury
Now, if the said Eslie Newton shall appear at the next term of the Circuit Court, and from term to term thereafter until discharged, and abide by and perform whatever sentence may be adjudged in said Court against him, then the above obligation to be void; otherwise to remain in full force and effect.

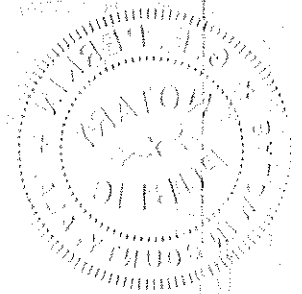
