On this day came the defendant, and both sides being ready for trial the witnesses were duly sworn and examined, and upon determining the law and the evidence, the defendant was adjudged guilty under the defense charged and fined ten dollars (\$10.00) and costs and on default of the payment of the fine was sentenced to the municipal jail of the Town of Foley for twenty days.

- 5. June 30, 1955. Comes the defendant and prays an appeal to the next ensuing session of the Circuit Court, which is granted on his entering into bond with bond and sureties.
- 6. June 30, 1933. The defendant gave bond as required by law and appealed to the Circuit Court.
