To The Honorable Francis W Hare, Judge of the Twenty First Judicial Circuit of Alabama, which includes Baldwin County:

Humbly complaining, your Orator, Daniel Harville, respectfully represents -
unto your Honor as follows:

1. Your Orator, Daniel Harville, and Mary Harville, the respondent, were legally and lawfully married at Bay Minette, Alabama in Baldwin County, on to wit December 26th, 1928, and lived together as husband and wife and lived at - different places in Baldwin County and on to wit, August 31st, 1929, a baby was born to them and when this baby, whom they named Ruby Broncel Harville, was two months old, respondent left your Orator; she came back after this and your Orator took her back and supported her, but they did not live as husband and wife and have not so lived for the past four years; over two years ago respondent again left your Orator and has not since lived with him; both your Orator and Respondent reside in Baldwin County, Alabama and their present Post Office Address is Bay Minette, Alabama; respondent has for some time been living at Butler Springs, Ala in Butler County, where until recently she made her home with her father or parents. She is now residing near Bay Minette, Ala. Your Orator, Daniel Harville has been a bona fide resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, for more than three years next before the filing of this Bill
2. That your Orator and said Mary Harville, after they intermarried lived together as husband and wife, off and on, until something about and more than two years ago, on to wit, Sept 1st, 1931, when the said Mary Harville, without any lawful excuse, voluntarily abandoned your Orator at or near Bay Minette, Alabama and more than two years before the filing of this Bill in this cause and since said abandonment they have not lived together.
3. That of the said intermarriage of your Orator with the said respondent, Mary Harville, there was born, the child, Ruby Broncell Harville, now four year old and who is now in the custody of your Orator at or near Bay Minette Alabama. That both your Orator and respondent are over the age of twenty one years and residents of the State of Alabama.
4. That the said Mary Harville, respondent aforesaid, since her last abandonment of your Orator, more than two years ago, on to wit Sept. 1st, 1931, has remained away from your Orator at all times since said last abandonment and has failed and refused to resume marital relations with your Orator and since said last abandonment, they have not lived together.

Wherefore, Your Orator, prays that the respondent, the said Mary Harville, by proper process of this honorable court be brought before this court and be directed to answer the charges herein made against her under the rules of this court; that she may be made a party defendant or respondent to this Bill of Complaint and that upon a final hearing of the evidence in the cause, your Honor will order, adjudge and decree that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between your Orator and the said Mary Harville be forever dissolved and that your Orator be permitted to marry again and that he may be given the custody of the minor child, Ruby Broncel Harville, now four years of age; and that your Honor will grant unto your Orator all such other and further or additional relief in the premises as in equity and good conscience he may be entitled to.
