Stapleton, Ala. April, 20th, 1940.

Hon. R.S.Dorck, Circuit Clark, Baldwin Co, Bayminatta, Ala.

On April Ist, 1940 I give to Mr E.B.Biggs of stapleton, Alaa check for the purchase of hunting license, as Mr Biggs stated that he would go to Bayminette on that date I also filled out applications for this license, and I have cancelled check to cover this license.

On April second I went out from Stapleton to see if could hear some turkeys gobble, and going along the road I met a Mr Taylor and this conversation transpired. Mr Taylor speaking did'nt you know that no hunting was allowed on this land I am in charge of this land and I am instructed to prosecute anyone hunting on this land, I said well I am sorry and if not allowed we will not do any hunting, as I were told that this land was not posted and no objections. Mr Taylor asked if I had hunting licanse and I stated that I had them at Mr Biggs at Stapleton who got them the day before, and he stated that was alright if Mr Biggs had them, But he had to report about hunting without a parmit. Returning to Stapleton I imaquired of Mr Biggs if he had my hunting license, and he stated that he did not go to Bayminette but mailed my check into the Probate Judge for them. in the following mail the probate judge returned the chack asking for application blank which Mr Biggs failed to enclose.

Later in the day I heard that warrent was issued for my arrest, and I got into my car and drove to Bayminette to Sas the game Warder and he stated he did not know if one had been filed or not but I made an appointment with him to go to the Justice of Peace office next day and find out, so when we gotthere Wr Taylor pulled some papers out of his pocket and give to the Justice and the justice remarked that, is this the charge and Mr Taylor said yes. Afetr explaining to the justice, thee justice said my cost is ten dollars and cost or \$14.75 I said well if this is what you call a court I wont stop here for justice and walked off. I have never been arrested neither have I had a trial but I was handed xx a appeal bond just as though I had been tried and convicted. Mre Taylor stated when we saw him in the road that he was the brother of Game warder teylor and when we got to Bayminestehe stated that it was he instead of his brother: This has been the most unusual thing that I have ever encountered , as I have violeted no law never was arrested neither have I ever been tried. I am confident that the laws of this state are for justoce and fairness, and I feel that an effort is being tried to allow me neither defence or trial. This is my plea for the court of records.
