YOU ARE HEREBY COMMANDED to notify Boone Rice, F. M. Ard and
J. J. Farrell,
that at the February 7th, Term, 1930 of the Circuit Court of said County,
a judgment was rendered against them of which the following is a copy

You will, therefore, by serving a copy hereof, notify the said Boone Rice, F. M. Ard
and J. J. Farrell, that the said judgment will
be made absolute against them at the next term of said Court,
unless they then appear and show cause against the same.
