D. J. Beech was, on the 11th day of Feb 1940 convicted in the Justice Court, Baldwin County, of the offense Hunting with an unlawful gun

and by the judgment of said Court sentenced to pay a fine of Twenty Dollars and court cost

And, whereas, the said D. J. Beech has this day prayed an appeal from said judgment to the Circuit Court of said County:

Now, if the said D. J. Beech shall appear at the next term of the Circuit Court, and from term to term thereafter until discharged, and abide by and perform whatever sentence may be adjudged in said Court against him, then the above obligation to be void; otherwise to remain in full force and effect.
