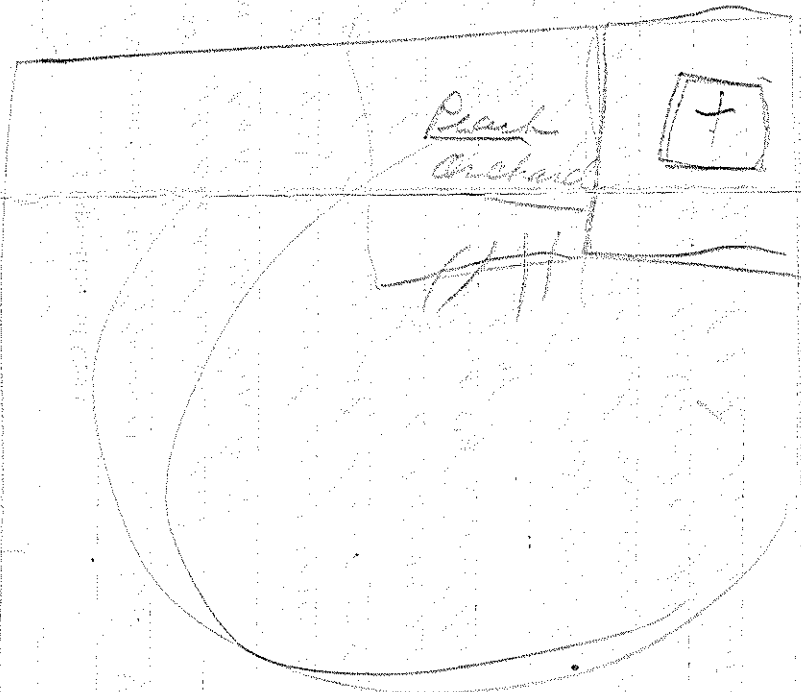

The Condition of the above obligation is such, That, whereas, the above bounden \_\_\_\_\_

J. A. Crittenden was, on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of July 1940  
convicted in the Justice Court, Baldwin County, of the offense Possession of  
more game fish than the law allows,

and by the judgment of said Court sentenced to pay a fine of \$10.00  
and court cost,

And, whereas, the said J. A. Crittenden  
has this day prayed an appeal from said judgment to the Circuit Court of said County:

Now, if the said J. A. Crittenden shall appear at  
the next term of the Circuit Court, and from term to term thereafter until discharged, and abide by and  
perform whatever sentence may be adjudged in said Court against him, then the above obligation to be  
void; otherwise to remain in full force and effect.
