The Grand Jury of said County charge that before the finding of this indictment Sallie Mae Clark, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, on her examination as a witness duly sworn to testify on the trial of one James Wilson, in the County Court of Baldwin County, under a complaint charging him with the offense of driving a motor vehicle while under the influence of intoxicating liquor, a misdemeanor, which said Court had authority to administer such oath, falsely swore that the said James Wilson was at his home during the entire night of June 28, 1936, the matters so sworn to being material, and the testimony of the said Sallie Mae Clark being wilfully and corruptly false, against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.

2. The Grand Jury of said County further charge that before the finding of this indictment Sallie Mae Clark, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, on the hearing of a misdemeanor criminal case in the County Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, in which the State of Alabama was Plaintiff and James Wilson, Defendant, being duly sworn by the Judge of said Court who had authority to administer such oath, falsely swore that the said James Wilson was at his home during the entire night of June 28, 1936, the matters so sworn to being material and the oath of the said Sallie Mae Clark in relation to such matters being wilfully and corruptly false,

against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
