Norman Wilson, whose name is to the Grand Jury otherwise unknown, on his examination as a witness duly sworn to testify on the trial of one James Wilson, in the County Court of Baldwin County, under a complaint charging him with the offense of driving a motor vehicle while under the influence of intoxicating liquor, a misdemeanor, which said Court had authority to administer such oath, falsely swore that the said James Wilson was at his home during the entire night of June 28, 1936, the matters so sworn to being material, and the testimony of the said Norman Wilson being wilfully and corruptly false, against the peace and dignity of the State of Alabama.
