2. If the jury believe from the evidence that by the road or highway passing over the defendants' property, the value of that portion West of the said road or highway was entirely destroyed, then the jury ought to allow the defendants the full value of the land actually taken, together with the value of the land West of the said road or highway; and if, in addition to this, the value of the land East of the said road or highway was also diminished, the jury should also allow the defendants the value of this diminution.

3. The court charges the jury that if you believe from the evidence in this case that the value of the defendants' tract of land was diminished or reduced by the plaintiff's taking of a part of their said land, then you should allow the defendants the reasonable market value of the lands taken at the time of taking; and, in addition thereto, the amount by which the remaining land is diminished or reduced in value.
