My name is Guy Bradley. I live at Daphne in Baldwin County, Alabama. I am over twenty-one years of age.


The respondent Maggie Bradley is a resident of Daphne in Baldwin County, Alabama, and over twenty-one years of age.

In 1933 the respondent voluntarily abandoned my bed and board and has remained away voluntarily and continuously since that time. I gave the respondent no reason for leaving me, and have done nothing toward keeping her away. I supported and cared for her as best I could while she was with me, and have tried to get her to come back and live with me, but she refused and continues to refuse to live with me.



Julio Corte a witness for the Complainant being first duly sworn, deposes and says:

My name is Julio Corte. I live at Belforest in Baldwin County, Alabama. I know the Complainant and the Respondent in the above styled cause and have known them for the past several years. I know of my own personal knowledge that for more than two years next preceding the filing of the bill of complaint in this cause that the Complainant and Respondent have not lived together as man and wife. The Respondent is working for and on our place.
