

THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION IS SUCH, That whereas, the above bounden F. A. Bullock was, on the 4th day of April 1936 convicted in the County, of the offense Violating fish law

and by the judgment of said Court sentenced to \$25.00 and cost

And, whereas, the said F. A. Bullock has this day prayed an appeal from said judgment to the Circuit Court of said County:

Now, if the said F. A. Bullock shall appear at the next term of the Circuit Court, and from term to term thereafter until discharged, and abide by and perform whatever sentence may be adjudged in said Court against him, then the above obligation to be void; otherwise to remain in full force and effect.
