Baldwin County from a judgment rendered against him in favor of said State
by Thomas V. Vassell
a justice of the peace for said county, for the sum of Eight dollars and 75
Dollars, debt in said appeal, shall pay such judgment, both as to
debt and costs as may be rendered against him by the said County Court of
Baldwin County, then, in either of said events, this obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full
force and effect.
