TO THE HONORABLE TELFAIR J. MASHBURN, JR., JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA, SITTING IN EQUITY:

Your Orators, Lyman H. Wilson and Flora Belle Wilson, present this Bill of Complaint against the unknown heirs of Joseph Bidner, Deceased, Mrs. John Stine, John Bidner and Mike Bidner and, thereupon, your Orators complain and show unto the Court and your Honor as follows:

- l. Your Orators are each over twenty-one years of age and residents of Mobile County, Alabama. The heirs of Joseph Bidner, Deceased, are unknown. Your Orators have made diligent inquiry to ascertain the names of the said heirs and their places of residence, as your Orators believe is not in the State of Alabama. Mrs. John Stine, a daughter of Joseph Bidner, Deceased, is over twenty-one years of age and a resident of Cairnbrook, Pennsylvania, Post Office Box 298. John Bidner, a son of Joseph Bidner, Deceased, is over twenty-one years of age, a non-resident of the State of Alabama and a resident of Central City or Cairnbrook, Pennsylvania. Mike Bidner, a son of Joseph Bidner, Deceased, is over twenty-one years of age and a non-resident of the State of Alabama, whose residence and post office address is unknown and cannot be ascertained after diligent inquiry to ascertain the same.
- 2. Your Orators claim to own and are in the actual, quiet and peaceable possession of the following described property situated in Baldwin County, Alabama, to-wit:

The Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter, Section 22, Township 5 South, Range 3 East.

3. The Respondents claim or are reputed to claim come right, title or interest in, lien or encumbrance on the said land; no suit is pending to enforce or test the validity of such title, interest in, lien or encumbrance on the said land and your Orators present this Bill of Complaint against the said Respondents to sattle the title to the said land and to clear up all doubts and disputes concerning the same. ### PRAYER FOR RELIEF

Your Orators further pray that upon a final hearing of this cause the Court will make and enter a proper decree against the Respondents and each of them, quieting your Orators? title to the said land, adjudging and decreeing that your Orators are the owners of the said land in their own right, that the title thereto is in them, that the above described mortgage be cancelled and forever quieting their title against the said Respondents and adjudging and decreeing that the said Respondents and each of them are without right, title or interest in the said land, have and hold no encumbrance thereon and that they and each of them be permanently and perpetually enjoined from attempting to enforce or collect the indebtedness secured by the said mortgage or from foreclosing it in any way or manner. Your Orators further pray for such other, further and general relief as they may be equitably entitled to, the premises considered.
