It is further ordered, adjudged and decreed that neither party to this suit shall again marry except to each other until sixty days after the rendition of this decree, and that if appeal is taken within sixty days, neither party shall again marry except to each other during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that the Complainant and Respondent be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon the payment of the cost of this suit.

It is further ordered that Charley Wilson the Complainant pay the cost herein to be taxed, for which execution may issue.

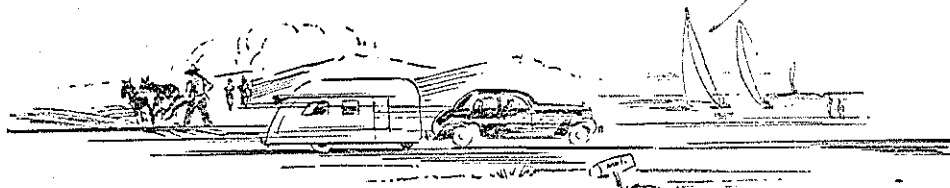

20, 1924, and lived together as husband and wife until in 1938.



The Respondent and I married on September 20, 1924, and we lived together as husband and wife until in 1938.

The Respondent in 1938 voluntarily abandoned my bed and board and has remained away voluntarily and continuously since that time. The Respondent and I have no children. I haven't had any word from the Respondent since she left me.
